Preference will be given to submissions relevant to the conference theme, 'Heraldic Hierarchies: Identities, Status and State Intervention in Early Modern Heraldry'. A more detailed list of related themes is given on the website. Please note that your powerpoint should be in more than one language if possible since the audience will include people of different nationalities. Papers will be considered for publication in the proceedings after acceptance by the Scientific Committee. The Committee does not need to justify its decisions.

Applicants for funding should normally be graduates studying for a higher degree, or have recently graduated with a PhD or Master's degree, whose dissertation is on a heraldic topic, or on a theme closely related to heraldry. Successful applicants for funding must present their work in person at Antwerp and are expected to attend the whole colloquium. Students must supply all supporting documentation for their expenses.
